From the Vicar

My dear Friends

I should like to thank the many people who contributed in many different ways to our joyful observance of Christ-mas.

It was a great pleasure to welcome the Headington Singers to All Saints' once again for their Christmas Concert and the members of the Preparatory Department of Headington School for their Christingle and Carol Services. The singing of our own Choir at the Annual Festival Service of the Nine Lessons and Carols on the Sunday before Christmas was absolutely splendid, and the Advent Carol Service on the first Sunday in Advent has clearly become a fixture in our calendar of Worship. Very many thanks to all those who kindly sent Christmas cards to the Vicarage – much appreciated.

We shall all wish to congratulate our good friend The Reverend Ken Campbell on his appointment as Head of the Emmanuel Christian School at Littlemore. Ken has accepted a demanding and challenging job which calls for the support of our prayers and interest.

A very early Easter in 2016 means that Lent begins very early this year. I have come up with a course of sermons for the Sunday mornings in Lent which will lead us into our Holy Week Mission – they are: - (1) Block off – (2) Read on – (3) Pray in – (4) Join with – (5) Kneel at – and (6) Celebrate with. I invite anyone to come to the Vicarage on the Sunday evenings in Lent from 8pm – 9pm when we will discuss the message of these Sermons. As the members of this Commission were unable to agree about this appointment when they met last year it is all the more important that we should pray for them in the hope that they will be led in their thinking and decision making by the Holy Spirit of God.
