Bishop David, who officiated at a Confirmation Service in All Saints' in 2015, was trained for the Sacred Ministry of the Church at King's College London. Following an Assistant Curacy in Liverpool, he moved to Christchurch for his second curacy. His first incumbency was at Hythe. He then moved to Romford and served as Rural Dean and as an Honorary Canon of Chelmsford Cathedral, in addition to his parochial duties. This led to his appointment as Archdeacon of Southend. Eight years later he was appointed Bishop of Warrington.
