From the Vicar

My dear Friends

We have all heard of the death of our good friend Bob Hayward with great sorrow. A serious illness took him into the John Radcliffe Hospital where he underwent major surgery from which he never regained consciousness. We give our love and condolences to Bob's three children, Jemma, Hollie and Jamie. Bob spent much of his life in Oxford living in Valentia Road before his family moved to the Sandhills estate. Confirmed as an adult by Bishop Peter Walker in All Saints' on 21st March 1992, Bob recently played an ever increasing and important part in the life of All Saints' as one of our part time honorary Vergers. Inviting him to take on this role, proved to be one of my more inspired moments. He clearly enjoyed being a Verger and was becoming more and more useful. He has been called away from a comparatively minor schedule to a far greater role among the faithful departed in the Communion of Saints'.

I am delighted to report that, with the approval of the Church Wardens and with the support of the choir, I have appointed Mr Rory Moules as our Director of Music from 1st August. From Downside School in Somerset, Rory came up

to Keble College Oxford where he was an organ scholar and was awarded a distinction in prelims – first year exams and took a first in music. He has been the organ scholar at The Queen's College Oxford for the last year and hopes to engage in research for a doctorate in the near future. He is an Associate of the Royal College of Organists and is already on his way to becoming a Fellow of the Royal College of Organists. Rory will be living in Church Garth. I much look forward to having him as a colleague.

Best wishes for happy and safe summer holidays – don't forget to take advantage of our Summer Festival of Music and the Arts. We are able to offer an outstanding programme for this year's festival with soloists coming from London and the Channel Islands as well as from Oxford. As we come to the 70th anniversary of the inauguration of the National Health Service, it is very appropriate for the opening recital to be in the capable hands of some who work in our local hospitals.
